Tokyo Opera City Art Gallery: "JAM: Tokyo-London" 8 Feb - 6 May (¥1000/¥800)

Curated by the Barbican Art Gallery and Tokyo Opera City Gallery, this massive compendium of Japanese and British street culture was well-received in London last year. Includes some of Japan's hottest photographers (Takashi HOMMA, Masafumi SANAI), media artists (Kazuhiro HACHIYA), designers (Groovisions, Naohiro UKAWA), painters (Yoshitomo NARA) and performance artists (Kyupi Kyupi), as well as a host of UK talent. >>[Listing](#)

RICE GALLERY by G2: "Masato KOBAYASHI: Works in Situ" 11 Jan - 16 Feb

Gent-based painter Masato KOBAYASHI came back to Japan for a month last year to create new work from 10 meters of canvas at Sagacho's Rice Gallery. Constantly seeking to minimize the distance between artist and work, KOBAYASHI applies paint directly with his hands and stretches his canvases himself (often in that order). Still littered with half-empty tubes of paint, the gallery has been left as it was the instant the works were completed. >>[Listing](#)

Chiba City Museum of Art: "SESSON: Super Eccentric of the Sengoku (Warring States) Era" 26 Jan - 3 Mar

Opting to avoid the glamour of Kyoto, 16th century painter SESSON spent much of his time in rural northern Japan. It was a wise move. Safely distant from the turbulence of the cities, a large number of his paintings survived the impending period of war - the tension and violence of which they nevertheless captured superbly. 130 works, including loans from the US and previously unexhibited paintings. >>[Listing](#)

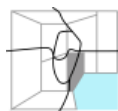
